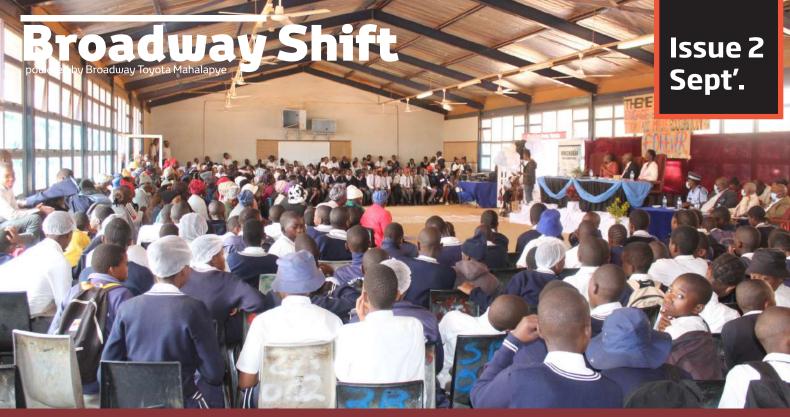
jumping in to support charm, promoting an enticing ladies' night at the rooftop terrace, while Botswana Life, the insurance giant, offered financial advice that could change the

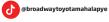
Broadway Toyota's commitment to education shines again
