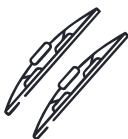

Team Botswana claims gold in Tokyo

When Botswana says pula, it means blessing. And in Tokyo, the heavens opened to crown a golden night for the men in blue.

For a moment, the world's fastest, Americans, thought it was business as usual. Rai Benjamin hit the home straight with two metres of daylight —

and maybe even allowed himself to picture yet another Stars and Stripes gold. After all, they'd owned this event nine times in the last ten. Easy, right? Wrong.

Because Botswana had other plans. Collen Kebinatshipi, already the 400m champion, stormed through like a ghost in the rain, slicing past South Africa and a stunned Benjamin, who could only watch as gold slipped away in 2:57:76. The USA were left to share silver with South Africa, both clocking 2:57:83 — but only one team danced in the puddles.

Letsile Tebogo, back with a vengeance after heartbreak earlier in Tokyo, delivered a blistering 44.05 to set the tone.

Bayapo Ndori carried the baton with steel before handing it to Kebinatshipi, who turned the floodlights into a stage for history. As the rain poured, Botswana danced — puddles splashing, spirits soaring, the world watching. This wasn't just a win. It was a nation's dream delivered, soaked in pula.

What you need to know about TAKATA AIRBAG SAFETY RECALL



In line with Toyota's global policy, Toyota SA Motors has initiated a recall campaign to replace

Takata-produced front airbag inflators. The reason for this is certain types of airbag inflators

manufactured by Takata were found to have a potential for moisture intrusion over time. Depending on the circumstances, this could create excessive internal pressure when the airbag is deployed and cause the inflator to rupture. In the event of an inflator rupture, metal fragments could pass through the airbag cushion material, striking and

possibly injuring the occupants in the event of an accident.

Affected owners will be notified by a Toyota dealer to bring their vehicle in for the service action. Please note that the replacement of the component will take one to two hours at no cost to the owner. Check if your vehicle is affected, it could save a life.
